Environmental protection (EP), rational use of natural resources, and reduction of negative impacts on employee and population health are becoming topical issues for more and more companies.

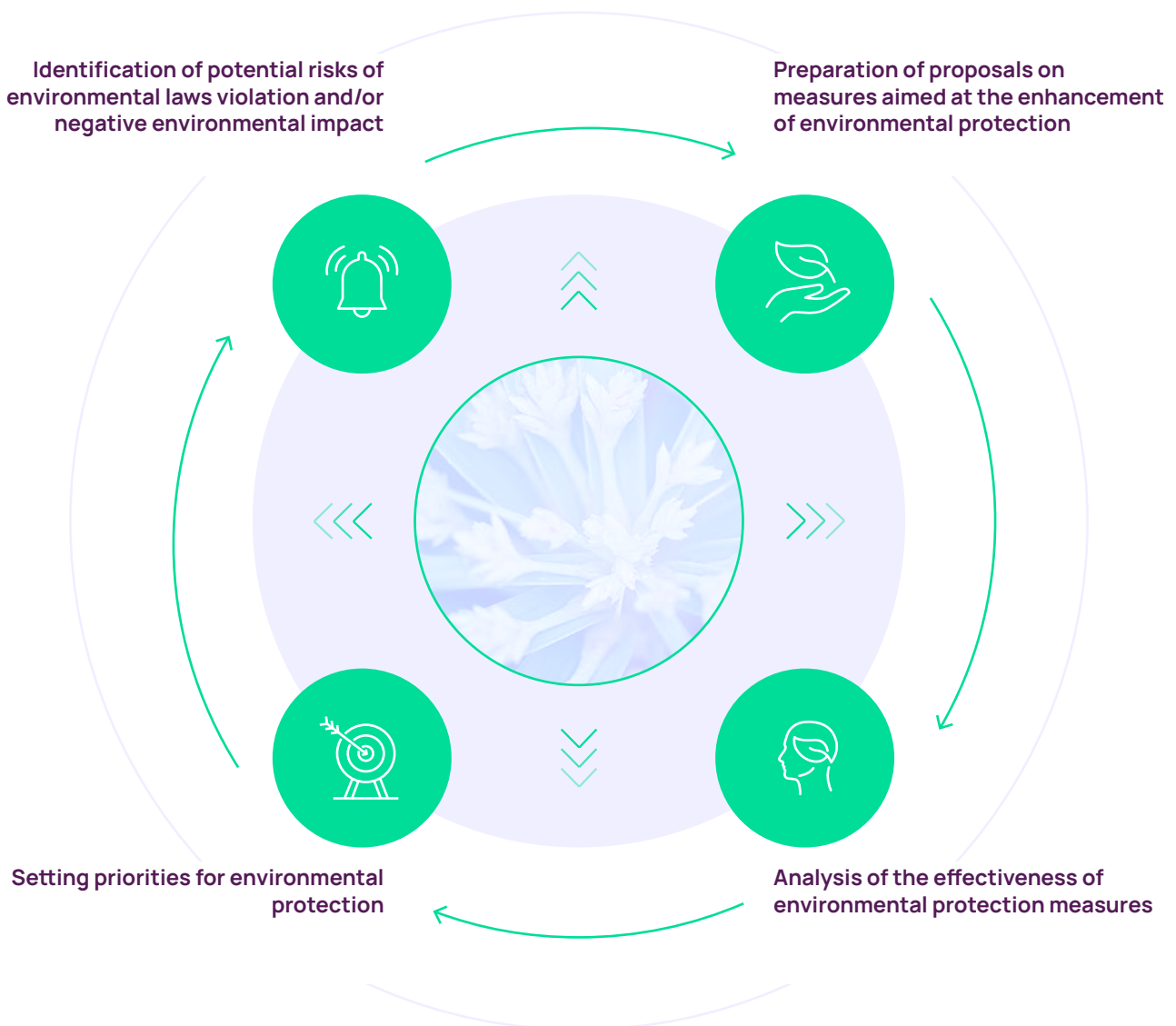
Environmental due diligence

is an assessment of the degree of compliance of operating activity and/or investment projects with requirements of national laws, regulatory acts and documents, directives, etc., in terms of environmental protection and use of natural resources, as well as compliance with requirements of international financial institutions and/or corporate standards.

For many companies, environmental safety is nowadays becoming one of the priorities of their development strategy.

Ecological assessment, or environmental due diligence is an effective and generally accepted environmental risk management mechanism.

Objectives of environmental due diligence

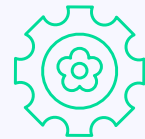


Goals of environmental due diligence

Assessment of the completeness of compliance of current or planned operations with the established requirements



Development of recommendations on EP enhancement measures



Preparation of proposals on setting up a mechanism to ensure compliance of operations with the established requirements

Assessment is performed in accordance with the recognized methodology **E1527 - 13 Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments: Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Process** of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM)

Stages of environmental due diligence and key measures

01



Preparatory

- Analysis of publicly available initial data, including the requirements of laws, international and corporate standards
- Preparation of a work program
- Preliminary assessment of the existing system for ensuring compliance of operations with environmental laws and corporate requirements

02



Main

- Visual inspection
- Interviews
- Documentation analysis
- Identification of key impacts and environmental risks

03



Final

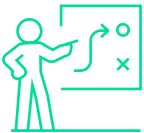
- Assessment findings report
- Presentation of preliminary results to the client
- Development of recommendations on the enhancement of environmental protection and rational use of natural resources
- Preparation of an action plan to implement the agreed recommendations



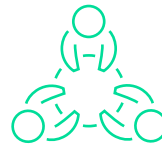
